General

Your application will be handled within 4 to 6 weeks. You will then be sent a Student Finance notice with a 'Bevraging BSN' form. Take this form with you to the Netherlands. You must fill out the form and return it to us once you have your citizen service number and Dutch bank account number. The form can also be downloaded from duo.nl/antillen.

Make sure you do not forget anything. The <u>Checklist Caribisch gebied</u> — <u>zaken regelen voor studiefinanciering</u> has an overview of everything you need to do regarding student finance and other things you need to arrange in the Netherlands.

Support

Students from the Caribbean region who are coming to the Netherlands to study, can register for a free support scheme to help them get accustomed to Dutch society, cultural habits and public transport. The support starts on the students' own island and continues in the Netherlands.

Students from the Dutch Caribbean can contact <u>TuranGoeloe</u> for a support scheme. For more information about local student finance they can contact <u>RCN-study financing</u>. Students from Aruba can go to Arubahuis for information about support. Students on Curacao can go to <u>Stichting Studiefinanciering Curacao (SSC)</u> and on St Maarten to <u>Division Study Financing</u>.

1.5 Nationality

If you do not hold Dutch nationality, please contact DUO at <u>KS-AA-UAF@duo.nl</u> and ask for the student finance options.

1.6 Non-Dutch bank account number

If you want to list a non-Dutch bank account number, you will have to pay the bank's transaction charges yourself. Contact DUO at MSS-AA-UAF@duo.nl to discuss the options.

2.3 Receiving post

If you have family or friends in the Netherlands, they may want to receive your post temporarily until you have moved there. Ask them if you can use their address in the Netherlands as your postal address. DUO will then send your post to that address.

3.5 Starting date

The academic year runs from 1 August to 31 July. If you are unsure what the correct starting date is, please contact your educational institution or check your education agreement.

4.3 Student finance components

Student finance comprises 5 possible components: a basic grant, a supplementary grant, an interest bearing loan, a tuition fees loan and a student travel product.

Basic grant

The basic grant depends on your living situation. If you are living on your own, the grant is higher than if you live at home. The basic grant is a gift or can become one.

Supplementary grant

You will receive the amount that you are entitled to. Always apply for the supplementary grant. Each year we will calculate whether you are entitled to it. How much you will receive depends, among other things, on your parents' income and the number of siblings with a supplementary grant. DUO calculates your supplementary grant using your parents' income from two years ago.

Student travel product

The student travel product is either a weekday product or a weekend product that you can use to travel on public transport for free or with a discount. If you do not yet have a citizen service number, the travel product will be compensated temporarily on a monthly basis. Please let us know as soon as you have your citizen service number, so we can get your travel product ready.

Interest bearing loan

Do not borrow more than you need to. Have you already applied for a supplementary grant? If you are entitled to one, you may not have to borrow as much, and possibly nothing at all. Use the calculation tool on duo.nl/rekenhulp.

After your studies, you must always repay the loan. DUO charges interest on your loan, from the first monthly instalment. More information about repayment can be found on duo.nl/terugbetalen.

If you check the box for a loan but fail to enter an amount, you will not receive a loan. You can always reapply for the loan at a later date.

Tuition fee loan

You can apply for a loan to pay your tuition fees. That loan is called a tuition fee loan ('collegegeldkrediet'). You can take out a loan for the statutory tuition fees or the institutional tuition fees.

Per academic year you cannot borrow more tuition fee loan than the amount of the tuition fees you have to pay, with a maximum of 5 times the amount of the statutory tuition fees. Per month you can receive 1/12 of your tuition fee loan.

After your degree programme, you repay the tuition fee loan under the same conditions as the loan.

5.1 Your parents' details

If you apply for a supplementary grant, we need the details of your legal parents. Your legal parents are the parents registered as your parents with the civil affairs department (Afdeling burgerzaken). A natural parent or adoptive parent counts as a legal parent, a foster parent or stepparent does not.

You should include evidence in the situations below:

I was not acknowledged by my parent:

 A copy or photo of a recent true copy of your birth certificate. You can request this copy at the civil affairs department of the island where you live.

I do not know who my legal parent is:

- a statement by you, explaining why you do not have the requested information about your parent.
- a recent, detailed statement by a professional, for example a student counsellor, a social worker, a psychologist or child services. The brochure Verklaring deskundige, which you can download from duo.nl/antillen, has more information about what that statement should contain.
- If possible, a statement by your other parent, showing why you do not have the requested information about your parent.

Problems with your parent(s)

In the following five situations, you can ask DUO to disregard your parents' income when calculating the supplementary grant:

- ${\tt 1.} \ Contact \ with \ your \ parent(s) \ was \ severed \ before \ your \ {\tt 12th} \ birthday.$
- 2. You have a severe and fundamental conflict with your parent(s). That conflict is not just about financial matters.
- 3. Your parent(s)' custody of you has ended.
- 4. The whereabouts of your parent(s) are unknown.
- The maintenance established for you cannot be collected for at least twelve consecutive months.

Use the form Verzoek inkomen ouders buiten beschouwing laten (Request to disregard parents' income) on duo.nl/antillen and add the form and requested documents to your application.

5.2 and 5.3 Details parent 1 and Details parent 2

Include the income details of your parent(s) in your application to speed up the calculation of the supplementary grant.

Your parent can request a personal income statement from the local tax authority, or download the form Verklaring inkomstenbelasting from duo.nl/antillen. We also need this statement when your parent has no income.

If you are as yet unable to send the income statements, please send your application for study finance to DUO. DUO will ask for the income details at a later date, so we can calculate your supplementary grant.
