Information session 'Studying in the Netherlands'

Will you be studying in the Netherlands during the next academic year? If so, is important for you to carefully arrange a few things. In order to help you, Dienst Uitvoering Onderwijs (DUO) is organising the 'Studying in the Netherlands' information session on Sint Maarten on Monday March 17 at 7 PM. Are you coming? Registration is required.

Session contents

During the session, you will hear about everything you need to arrange for your Dutch study financing. We will also explain how and why you should obtain a Dutch citizen service number (BSN) and everything you can do with it. And you will also be given several useful tips. For example, about applying for a DigiD and health insurance. The session is in English. Naturally, you can also ask questions during the session.
